

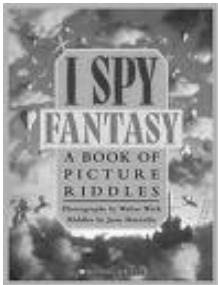
Family Fun at Fruitville Library!

Sew Fantastic and Fabulous!

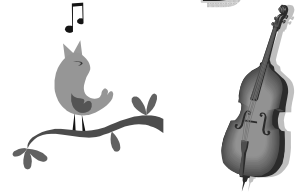
Make a variety of silly creatures, puppets, bags and more. Activities offered have varying levels of difficulty.

Puppet Party!

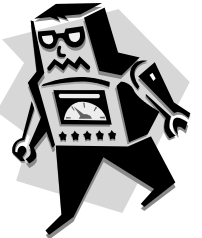
